

EVALUATION OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

The Superintendent or designee will implement an educational program for kindergarten through the twelfth grade in accordance with the following:

1. A written philosophy of education and educational goals shall give direction to the educational program and shall provide a basis for daily operations.
2. Curriculum and instruction shall be characterized by systematic planning, articulation, implementation, and evaluation.
3. Educational options may be made available to pupils.
4. An experimental program may be provided to meet the identified needs of pupils subject to prior approval by the Ohio Department of Education.
5. The educational program provided shall be evaluated at least once every five years. Evaluation procedures shall be conducted according to professionally recognized criteria and procedures.
