

STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT VIOLATIONS
(Loss of Driving Privileges)

Where the Superintendent receives information that a student of compulsory school age has been suspended, expelled, removed, or permanently excluded for a violation of the code of conduct that involves a firearm, knife, or other weapon, the Superintendent will, within two weeks of the disciplinary action, notify the Bureau of Motor Vehicles and the county juvenile judge.

In addition, the Superintendent may notify the Bureau of Motor Vehicles and juvenile judge if a student has been suspended, expelled, removed, or permanently excluded for a violation of the code of conduct that involves drugs or alcohol.
