

INOCULATIONS OF STUDENTS

Immunization against diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus, poliomyelitis, rubeola, rubella, and mumps is required for each student attending schools in the District unless the parent files an objection.

Students eligible for first grade and students new to the school system must present written evidence of similar immunizations, or written evidence to indicate that they are in the process of receiving such immunizations, to be completed no later than the day of entrance. Students failing to complete such immunizations within 14 days after entering will not be permitted to return to school.

The Board will require tuberculosis examinations in compliance with law.

All students are required to have documentation of two doses of live measles, mumps, and rubella vaccine in compliance with law.
