Superintendent Wright explained the process of the calendar committee. GEA President Martha Davis added the union was pleased with the options and the calendar selected. Mr. Morgan Saunders asked for the school calendar to be shared through Facebook once board approved.

Jeremy Hout presented the curriculum selection process of the district. He explained that the learning standards are the rules of the game and the approved model curriculum is the playbook. He outlined who and how the curriculum selection team forms and operates.

Parent Jordan Shaffer said he has seen an increase of bad behavior at the high school and asked if the Board saw a need for a full time resource officer. Superintendent Wright responded that local law enforcement has worked well with the district and the district has employees who have law enforcement training. Mr. Shaffer commented that his concern was with response time to the high school and with having someone who is there all the time to build relationships. The board discussed previous arranges with Rio Police Department and with other SROs. Superintendent Wright outlined the proactive approach the district has taken to provide counselors through Hopewell, attendance officer housed at GAHS and guidance counselors. Mr. Morgan Saunders added that all need to talk to state representatives who can change the Ohio Revised Code.

Superintendent Wright announced the Ohio School Boards Association proclaim January 2022 as School Board Recognition Month in order to build awareness and understanding of the vital function an elected board of education plays in our society. The Gallipolis City School District is joining with other districts throughout the state to recognize the important contributions school board members make to their communities. Even
